

PARENT PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

Dear Parent/Guardian

We are looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of *Rockbank Primary School's* parent payment arrangements for 2021.

Please find the fee schedule for *Grade Two* attached.

Rockbank Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

This year we have taken the liberty of ordering class sets of books and stationery to use in the classroom. This is a \$50 component that contributes to the overall cost of your yearly fees. Fees are due first week of February, You will receive an invoice on the 1st day of school and can be paid using bpay. The charge for 2021 is \$200 for all students.

If you want to purchase the books yourself please let us know by the 11th December, 2020.

Other costs will arise throughout the year to cover the cost of excursions, sporting activities and camps. Notes will be sent out for each of these activities as they happens.
